

QUT-NCAS offers PhD scholarships

QUT is located in Brisbane, Australia and invites applications from permanent university academics in Sri Lanka for the QUT and NCAS PhD scholarship program.

You will receive a full tuition fee sponsorship valued at approximately \$100,000 AUD over three years, provided by QUT (with potential for extension up to 4 years)

Living allowance of at least \$18,610 2018, indexed annually) each year for three years, airfares to Australia and overseas health cover costs are provided by National Centre for Advance Studies (NCAS) in Sri Lanka.

Applications are open from 23 March 2018. The closing date is 25 July 2018.

Entry requirements:

- Permanent members of academic staff of universities under the Grants Commission of Sri Lanka
- Master degree with minimum research component of 25% or a four year Bachelor degree with Honours 1st or 2nd class
- Grade Point Average (GPA) of at least 5.5 on a 7-point scale or equivalent.

In addition to the above requirements, all applicants should satisfy the general guidelines of the NCAS postgraduate grant scheme.
